### **“Lord, Hear Our Cry”**

**Leander Residents and Community Leaders Gather  
to Pray for our Nation  
64th Annual Observance of the National Day of Prayer  
Thursday, May 7, 2015**

Leander, TX, May 7, 2015—More than 75 community residents gathered this morning in Leander to celebrate the 64th annual National Day of Prayer and exercise their freedom to express their faith and pray for our nation.

The NDP Task Force selected **Lord, Hear Our Cry**, as the theme for the 2015 observance, emphasizing the need for individuals, corporately and individually, to place their faith in the unfailing character of their Creator, who is sovereign over all governments, authorities, and men. To further highlight the theme, I Kings 8:28 was chosen as the Scripture, *“Hear the cry and the prayer that your servant is praying in your presence this day.”*

The event closed with the annual balloon launch. As a symbolic gesture, attendees wrote prayers on small cards, tied them to the helium-filled balloons and then launched them in unison into the heavens.
